RIPARIAN REDBUDS

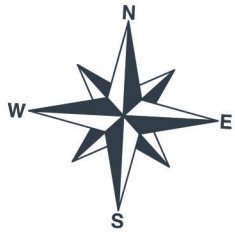
Visit this streamside habitat in April for early-spring blooms and sweet scents from the beautiful redbud trees.
